## I Miss My Daddy ... Update

This year Janet James, Trevor's mother, has been offered a 14x48 foot billboard for one month, free of charge by **Clear Channel**. **Rider Insurance** has agreed to sponsor it and a copy of the billboard is shown below.

Much has happened since Loretta wrote that story. New Jersey Senator Robert Andrews along with Senator James Beach, Assemblyman Nelson Albano and Winslow Township Mayor Suzanne Metzner, attended the event last year on May 2nd. The Mayor proclaimed May 2nd as Trevor James Day.

Congressman Robert Andrews will be introducing legislation on the national level in Trevor's honor. It will be for a uniform section for motorcycle safety and awareness in every states motor vehicle handbook. He also put an entry into the United States Congressional Record in Trevor's memory and honor.

On May 1st this year, Clear Channel has agreed to put the billboard up on that day to kick off **May as Motorcycle Awareness Month**. "We hope to have press and TV coverage as well as some public officials in attendance" said Janet James. Janet is also working on inviting New Jersey's new Governor.
